

## GENESIS 3

13 And the LORD God said unto the woman, What *is* this *that* thou hast done? And the woman said, <sup>R</sup>The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat.

14 And the LORD God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou *art* cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and <sup>R</sup>dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life:

15 And I will put <sup>R</sup>enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

16 Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy <sup>r</sup>conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire *shall be* <sup>r</sup>to thy husband, and he shall <sup>R</sup>rule over thee.

17 And unto Adam he said, Because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: cursed *is* the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat *of* it all the days of thy life;

18 Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee; and thou shalt eat the <sup>r</sup>herb of the field;

19 In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for <sup>R</sup>out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou *art*; and unto dust shalt thou return.

20 And Adam called his wife's name <sup>r</sup>Eve; because she was the mother of all living.

21 Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them.
