Satan used his greed for money to entice him into betroying the Lord Jesus-for thirty pieces of silver.

On the actual night of Itis betrayal we read these solemn words.

then entered Satan into him John 13 v27

Was God then defeated? Was His purpose thwarted? If so man would have been lost forever-With only an eternal hell to face.

In Gen 3 v 15 we read of another "seed". This "seed" is the seed of the woman. There would be perpetual enmity between the "seed" of the serpent and seed of the woman.

Ultimately the seed of the woman, though suffering himself, would be victorious over the seed of the serpent.

What does this mean? Who is this seed?
