day or to-morrow will we go into such a city and spend a year there, and traffic and make gain, ye who do not know what will be on the morrow, ([for] what [is] your life? It is even a vapour, appearing for a little while, and then disappearing,) instead of your saying, If the Lord should [so] will and we should live, we will also do this or that.

Do you ever consider what may or may not be the Lord's will for you each day?

Do you ever actually say "If the Lord should will and I live, I will do this orthat; or go here or there?

The man in the parable left God out of his plans altogether.

Nor did he consider how fragile and brief
